What can't be accepted at the sites

- Fridges, freezers, asbestos, car batteries, concrete, hardcore, hazardous chemicals, oil, paint, plasterboard, trade waste or tyres. For advice on getting rid of these, please contact Surrey

County Council on contactcentre@surreycc.gov.uk or **03456 009 009**. We cannot accept any rubbish brought to the site in a lorry. Please do not leave waste if the vehicle is not there. This is flytipping, which is illegal dumping and a crime.
