What does Felbridge Parish Council Do?

FPC are your local representatives on matters such as

- ❖ Village planning and development
- ❖ Highways and footpaths
- ❖ Road safety and speed limits
- ❖ Open spaces and amenities
- ❖ The environment
- ❖ FPC gives financial assistance to local organisations, through donations
- ❖ Public nuisance

We do not have the power to make final decisions on these matters, but work on your behalf to influence and negotiate with the authorities that do. e.g. Tandridge District Council, Surrey County Council, Mid Sussex District Council, local Police authorities and others.

How Often do FPC Meet?

The council hold a full council meeting on the first Thursday of every Month except for January and August. Planning Meetings are held fortnightly on the first Thursday of the month, following our main monthly meeting, and on the 3rd Thursday of every month.

Meetings are held in the Felbridge Village Hall. A list of all meeting dates and times for the current year can be found on the Parish Notice boards around the village and on our website www.felbridge-pc.org.uk

Can I attend FPC Meetings?

Yes, all meetings are open to the public. The first 10 minutes of full parish council meetings (1st Thursday of the month) are available for members of the public to raise issues or ask questions. After this time, you can no longer raise an issue but you may stay for the duration of the meeting. You can of course discuss any matter relating to FPC with councillors or the Clerk outside of the meeting.

If you plan to attend a meeting to raise an issue with the council, it can be helpful to speak with the Parish Clerk who can advise you of what to expect and if there is any information that it would be useful for you to bring with you.

Want to get involved?

There are currently 7 serving parish councillors. Each of these roles is unpaid and voluntary. A councillor is entitled to claim limited expenses for parish business, but this is very rare. Councillors are expected to attend, where possible, most monthly full and planning meetings.

From time to time a councillor may retire or move out of the area. At this time, and when elections are being held, any resident of the parish may apply to be a parish councillor. Councillors generally serve a minimum of 4 years. The chairman and vice chairman are chosen or re-elected each year by the parish councillors present at the annual meeting.
