



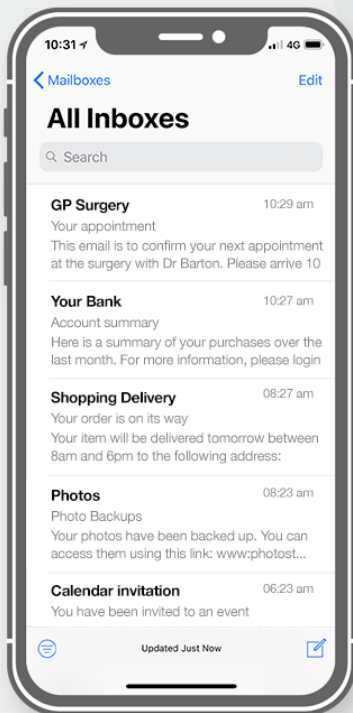

Secure your email account in 2 simple steps

Why are email accounts so important?

- Use three random words to create a strong, separate password for your email account.
