### You did it! Food waste recycling makes huge saving

Last year Surrey residents saved an extra £200,000 just by putting more food waste in caddies! This year residents are being urged to boost those savings by recycling even more of their food waste.

Residents can make such a huge difference simply because it costs less than half as much to recycle food waste, as it does to dispose of it. If all Surrey's food waste was recycled, it would save an extra £3 million a year.

The large number of Surrey residents recycling their food waste has also helped Surrey reach joint top of the recycling league table of the 32 two-tier (county and district) local councils in England.

Residents can put all their food waste into their caddies, which are collected every week. Caddies can be lined with any kind of plastic bag (no black sacks) and smelly food waste can be put in a tied carrier bag and taken to outside food bins straight away.
