

# RTC Woodcock Hill update

We can now confirm that two men sadly died as a result of the collision yesterday (Monday 22 January) shortly after 6.30pm involving a grey Skoda Octavia and a white LDV Maxus van. Both men were travelling in the Skoda when it collided with the van. The pair were pronounced dead at the scene.

Three people in the van, a man, woman and a 2-year-old child were all taken to Sussex County hospital. The adults suffered serious but not life threatening injuries. The child was uninjured.

Anyone who saw the incident, or the manner of driving of either vehicle in the minutes before the collision, is asked to contact Surrey Police on 101 quoting reference PR/45180008212. We are also keen to speak to anyone who may have recorded dashcam footage from the area between 6.15pm and 6.35pm on the 22 January.
